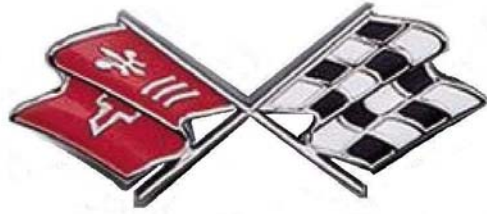

approaches.

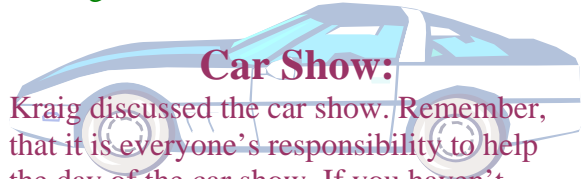
One of the biggest accomplishments
