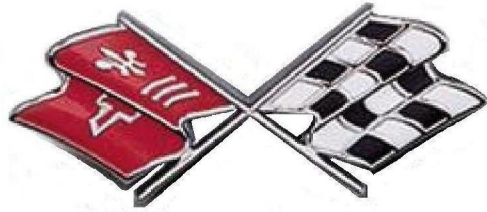

8/19- SEWCC Car show at the Kenosha Co. Center, Hwy 45 and 50, Bristol.

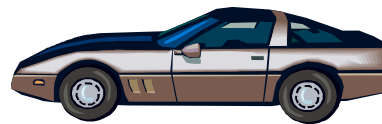
Labor Day Fest Kenosha- Jeannie will get more details. We may be able to show up with 10-15 cars.
