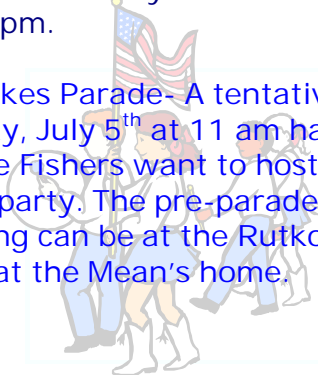
Hot Rod power tour. June 7<sup>th</sup> -16. It ends in Madison at the Alliant Energy Center.
