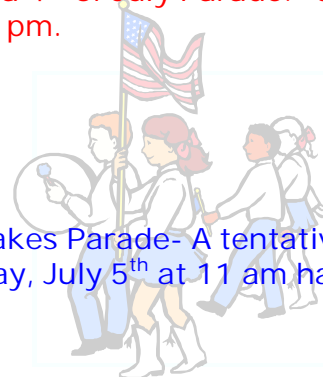
Tom Walther will host a car run on Saturday May 3rd. Meet at Famous Daves in Kenosha on Hwy 50 at noon.
