**Vice President Report:** see car show report

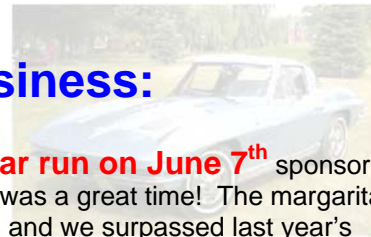
**Secretary's Report-** No board meeting- no

**Kim Manna**- McGuire's will send supplies and bag stuffers two weeks before the show.

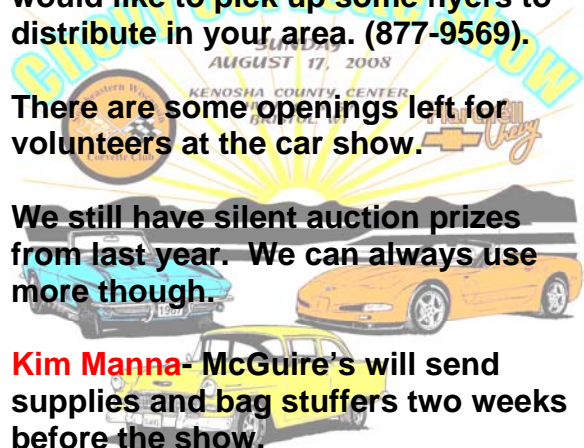
There was discussion about another modified class- a '55-57 modified class. Dick K. says that Rat Rods can't compete in this.
