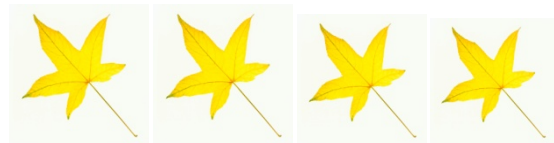
Chevy Vettefest: Nov. 22nd and 23rd
