2012 SEWCC Christmas party discussed by members. We are looking at 12-8 or 12-15. Club members are looking at various places and we will decide on the location at the next meeting.

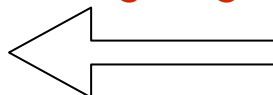
JEDDYFEST
