### **SEWCC club cars competing for car show awards**

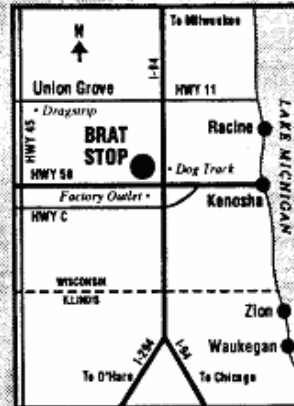

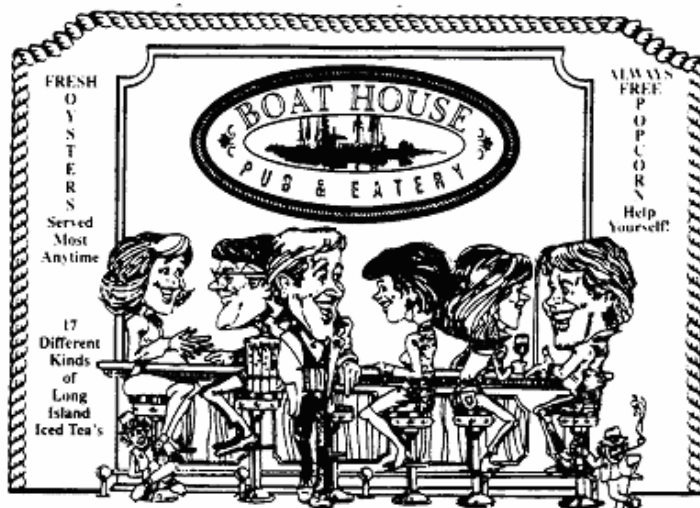
